P1 REGISTRATION EXERCISE 2026- PHASE 1 REGISTRATION

Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2020 and 1 January 2021 (both dates inclusive) and has a sibling studying in our school.

For the 2026 P1 Registration Exercise (2026 P1 Ex), parents who are registering their younger child under Phase 1 are to register during the Phase 1 registration period from 30 June to 2 July 2026.

If your child is a non-SC / non-PR and thus not eligible for Phase 1, please submit an online indication of interest from 19 May 2026 to 25 May 2026.

TRAVEL DECLARATIONS

To ensure that schools continue to be a healthy and safe environment for all, we require parents/ guardians to make a travel declaration for your child/ ward if he/ she will be travelling for the holidays.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE > TRAVELS]. For travel during the school holidays, indicate both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit, by 31 May 2026. Only one parent is required to make the declaration.

If your child/ ward is not travelling during the holidays, no action is required. When planning your travel, please refer to <https://www.ica.gov.sg/enter-transit-depart> for more information and updates.

If there is a change in travel plan(s) after declaration, please submit a new travel declaration via PG if there is a change in travel destination or inform the school if the travel plan(s) are cancelled.
